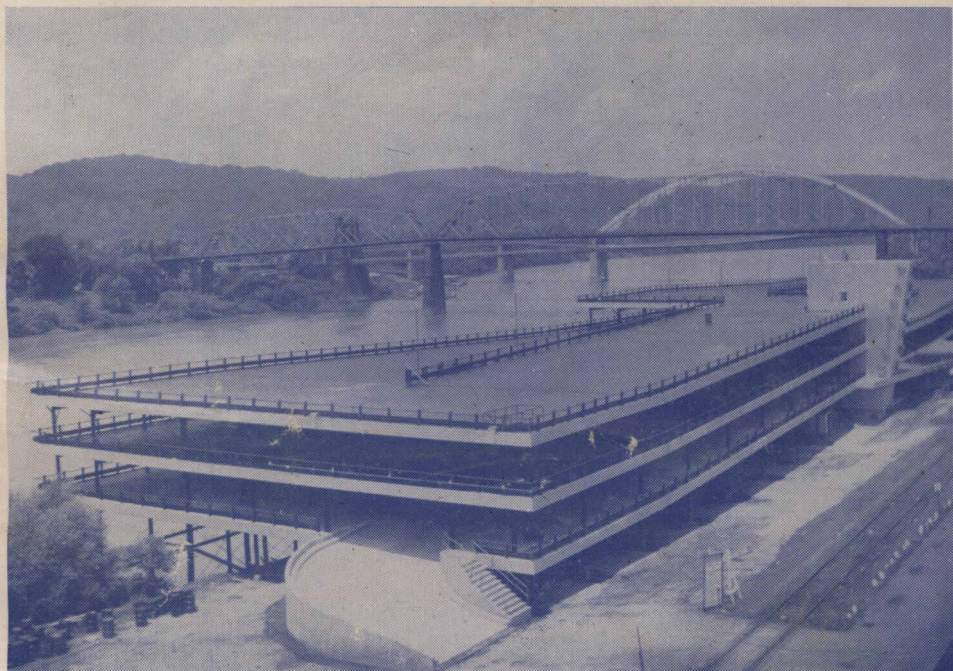

FACTS WORTH NOTING

Wheeling's new Wharf Parking Garage is a Municipal project constructed on Water Street in the center of downtown Wheeling. The over all cost is approximately ONE MILLION DOLLARS financed through the issuance of Revenue Bonds.

The garage has four floors including upper deck and has a capacity of 945 cars. The size of the structure is 600 by 120 feet or twice as long as a football playing field. The parking decks are 233,000 square feet or about five acres.

Basic materials used in this construction include 1,200 tons structural steel (100 trailer loads); 4,000 cubic yards concrete. Enough $\frac{3}{8}$ inch reinforcing rods to reach from Wheeling to Pittsburgh were required in the construction. The foundations were driven to solid rock 70 feet below first floor level representing about 385 concrete pilings, which if placed end to end would approximate four miles. For customer convenience and to eliminate wasted space, difficult turns and unnecessary ramps, the floor decks are sloping.

One passenger elevator and three sets of stairs are provided to facilitate ingress and egress. Time required to drive from top deck to exit at 15 M.P.H. is 82 seconds.

Construction of the Wheeling Wharf Parking Garage was begun August 1, 1955, and the garage was dedicated August 1, 1956. Inclement weather and other factors beyond the contractors' control delayed earlier completion of the facility.
