Week of September 28: Pumpkins

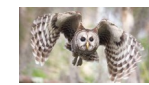


Who doesn't love a pumpkin?

Activity and Story: We will make an owl viewer and read *Hootenanny: A festive Counting Book*.



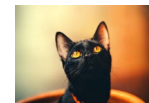
Week of October 12: Scarecrows
