



What parents and care givers can expect from Toddler Time and Story Time:

Toddler Times employ the “Mother Goose on the Loose” method for helping young children develop early literacy and school readiness skills. This method combines music, movement, art, picture books, and puppets with nursery rhymes in a fun way. The programs lasts approximately 30 minutes and are geared to children from birth to age 3.

Story Time programs introduce young children to books, rhymes, songs, crafts and other fun activities. These programs incorporate the early literacy skills that children must master before they can learn to read. Story Times are designed for children 3 -5 years of age, though all ages are welcome.

Story Time featured story and craft: We will read *One Hundred Hungry Ants* and make egg carton ants.

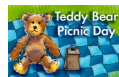


Week of August 23-Picnic Friends
